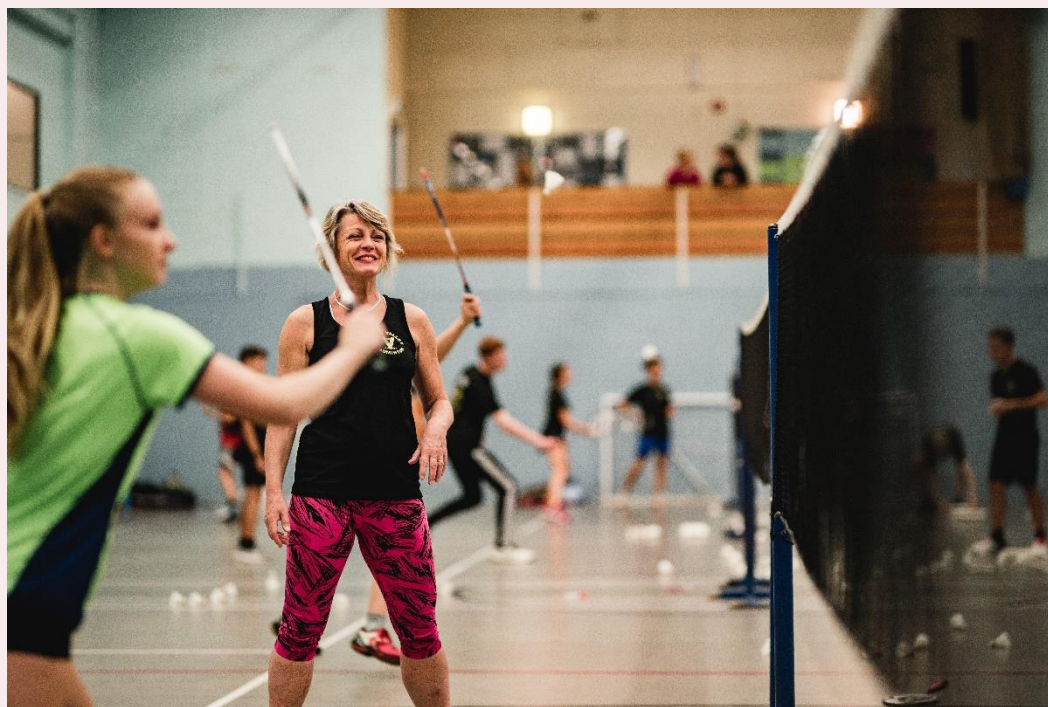

- Complete a recognised safeguarding and protecting children's course

Young Leadership Awards (13-19yrs)

Young Officials Award

The Badminton Young Official Award (YOA) is aimed at young people aged 13-19. The course is a combination of practical and theory sessions designed to equip the Young Official with the necessary skills and a qualification that will allow them to officiate at badminton events. The YOA is delivered by trained Badminton England Tutors. Each candidate will receive a resource pack.

Badminton Young Leader Award The Badminton England Young Leader Award (YLA) is an opportunity for leaders to develop skills that will assist them to lead and volunteer in their local badminton environment including delivering *SmashUp!* sessions and Racket Pack festivals. The award is aimed at anyone aged 13 and over and is delivered through a series of workshops. All resources to deliver and support the YLA can be downloaded from our YLA Moodle page. In order to access this you will need to purchase a 1 or 2 year licence from Badminton England. The YLA can be delivered by teachers, registered coaches or by Badminton England specific tutors.

SmashUp! Activator Training

Smash Up! is a modern mix of school mates, baseline pumping music and big hitting badminton challenges that makes after school badminton court time a social hub.

Badminton England are looking to build up a nationwide pool of enthusiastic, engaging 'activators' whom we can call upon when delivery opportunities are available, to work within secondary schools and lead Smash Up! Extracurricular clubs! This qualification takes both the form of an online module which is available to individuals that already hold coaching/leadership qualifications or 4 hour training course which includes both practical and classroom based activities.
